Fans who attend are asked to donate canned goods and nonperishable food items. There will be collection bins, an *Olney HELP* table with brochures and information, and Jacqui Vok, the Executive Director, will throw out the first pitch. Interestingly, her son played with the Cropdusters Baseball team for two years.



Knine Rescue will be featured, along with dogs who will be up for adoption, at the **Saturday**, **June 28**, **2025**, **6:30** p.m. home game vs. the Southern Maryland Senators. Emily Cavey and Rachel Rosen of *Knine Rescue* will have a promotional table and collection bins for Cropduster fans to bring donated animal items. They will also be interviewed by Cropdusters Announcer, Kevin Ruth.
