The OBGC scholarship honors the memory of Blake Owen Conrad, who was a member of the Sherwood H.S. football team and served in the Maryland Army National Guard. Brad Scott, OBGC Executive and Athletic Director, stated, “We believe Calum is deserving of this prestigious scholarship because he is a selfless, dedicated athlete who puts others before himself - just like Blake Conrad. He is an upstanding athlete within the greater Olney community.”

Jagannathan recently graduated from Sherwood H.S, and will attend the University of Maryland in the fall to study mechanical engineering and would like to walk onto the Terrapins baseball team.
